OUR VINEYARDS





Schlossböckelheim

Our **vineyards** in Schlossböckelheim, spanning 3 hectares, are located on the unique **Königsfels** and Heimberg slopes. The volcanic porphyry soil, rich in minerals, gives our **wines** their distinct character, with a refreshing taste and a Caipirinha-like finish. Perfect with seafood, Asian cuisine, or light dishes.

Niederhausen

The 5,4 hectare **vineyards** in Niederhausen are known for their mineral-rich soils, producing elegant Rieslings with freshness and complexity. The 4.5 km **wine** trail offers stunning views of the **vineyards** and surrounding landscape.





Bad Kreuznach

The **vineyards** in Bad Kreuznach cover 27 hectares in a region known for its scenic landscapes and rich **winemaking** tradition. With clay, gravel, and sandstone soils, wines from sites like Hinkelstein and Kahlenberg are characterized by fruity freshness and mineral elegance. The historic Kahlenberg, since 1499, produces exclusive, aged top **wines**. Bad Kreuznach combines excellent viticulture with unique cultural and culinary diversity.

Riesling Alte Reben trocken (dry)

This full-bodied, dry **Riesling** impresses with its fine bouquet and mineral character. The **vines** grow on sun-drenched soils with gravel content, giving the **wine** its unique balance and depth. An ideal companion for everyday enjoyment.

Hinkelstein **Riesling** Kabinett trocken (dry)

An elegant, dry **Riesling** with a fine bouquet, mineral notes, and a balanced structure. The vines thrive on sun-drenched gravel-clay soils, giving the **wine** its characteristic style. Perfect with braised fish and lemon, and a true reflection of our **winery's** signature.





Kreuznacher Riesling feinherb (off-dry)

A lively **Riesling** with a harmonious balance of fine fruit sweetness and refreshing acidity. Its elegant lightness and typical **Riesling** aromas make it a versatile companion for many occasions.

Blanc de **Noir**

The 2023 Blanc de **Noir** delights with a harmonious body and mineral structure, making it a versatile pairing for many dishes. Fresh Pinot **Noir** grapes are fermented in stainless steel, enhancing its elegant freshness. Aromas of red fruits like blueberry and strawberry are complemented by a creamy touch. Best served at 4-8°C.





Kreuznacher Scheurebe

This Scheurebe, a blend from two **vineyards**, captivates with its fruity, refreshing character and aromatic bouquet. The variety, developed in Alzey in 1916, combines the best qualities of Silvaner and **Riesling**.

Niederhäuser Pfingstweide **Riesling**

A fresh, fruity **Riesling** from a monopole **vineyard**, sheltered by surrounding hills. Harmonious, elegant, and lightly fresh – perfect with Asian cuisine or as a long drink. Serve at 8°C.





Schlossböckelheimer Königsfels **Riesling** Kabinett

This **Riesling** captivates with its mineral freshness and notes of citrus and green apple. The volcanic porphyry soil adds depth and elegance. With pleasant acidity and a long finish, it pairs perfectly with seafood or Asian cuisine, reflecting the region's diversity.

Kreuznacher Kahlenberg **Riesling** Spätlese (late harvest)

This **Riesling** late harvest comes from a single **vineyard** with loamy soil and gravel. It impresses with the refined taste of ripe grapes and a good balance between fruit sweetness and acidity. A harmonious **wine** with a full, mature aroma.





Kauzenberg Gewürztraminer **Spätlese** (late harvest)

This Gewürztraminer late harvest grows on a gentle, south-facing slope planted in 1967. The **wine** delights with a refined, appealing taste, a fragrant aroma, and a light spiciness. It pairs perfectly with blue cheese or Asian cuisine.

Niederhäuser Felsen Steyer **Riesling** Auslese

This noble sweet **Riesling** from the estate's oldest vineyard, replanted in 1952, boasts a fine bouquet, noble flavors of ripe grapes, delicate minerality, and perfect balance. A refined **Riesling** with depth and character.

Schlossböckelheimer Königsfels **Riesling** Kabinett

A fresh, fruity **Riesling** from a steep, south-facing site. It features a fine bouquet, refreshing acidity, and a charming, crisp character. A **wine** that ages well while maintaining its youthful freshness.

Kreuznacher Krötenpfuhl **Riesling** Auslese

A full-bodied, noble sweet **Riesling** from a single **vineyard**. With a fine bouquet and the noble taste of ripe grapes, this **wine** offers a true tasting experience. The south-facing site and loamy soil with gravel content add depth and character.
